

If you can't afford a decent 'hutch'...

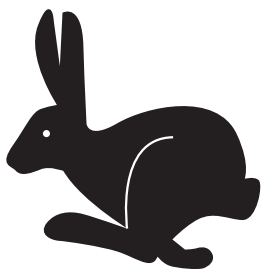


Think 'outside the box' a hutch is not the only home
