- Can I give him the the correct diet?

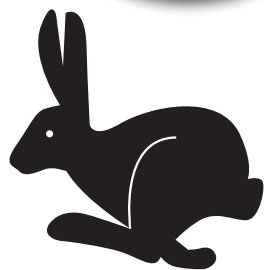
